

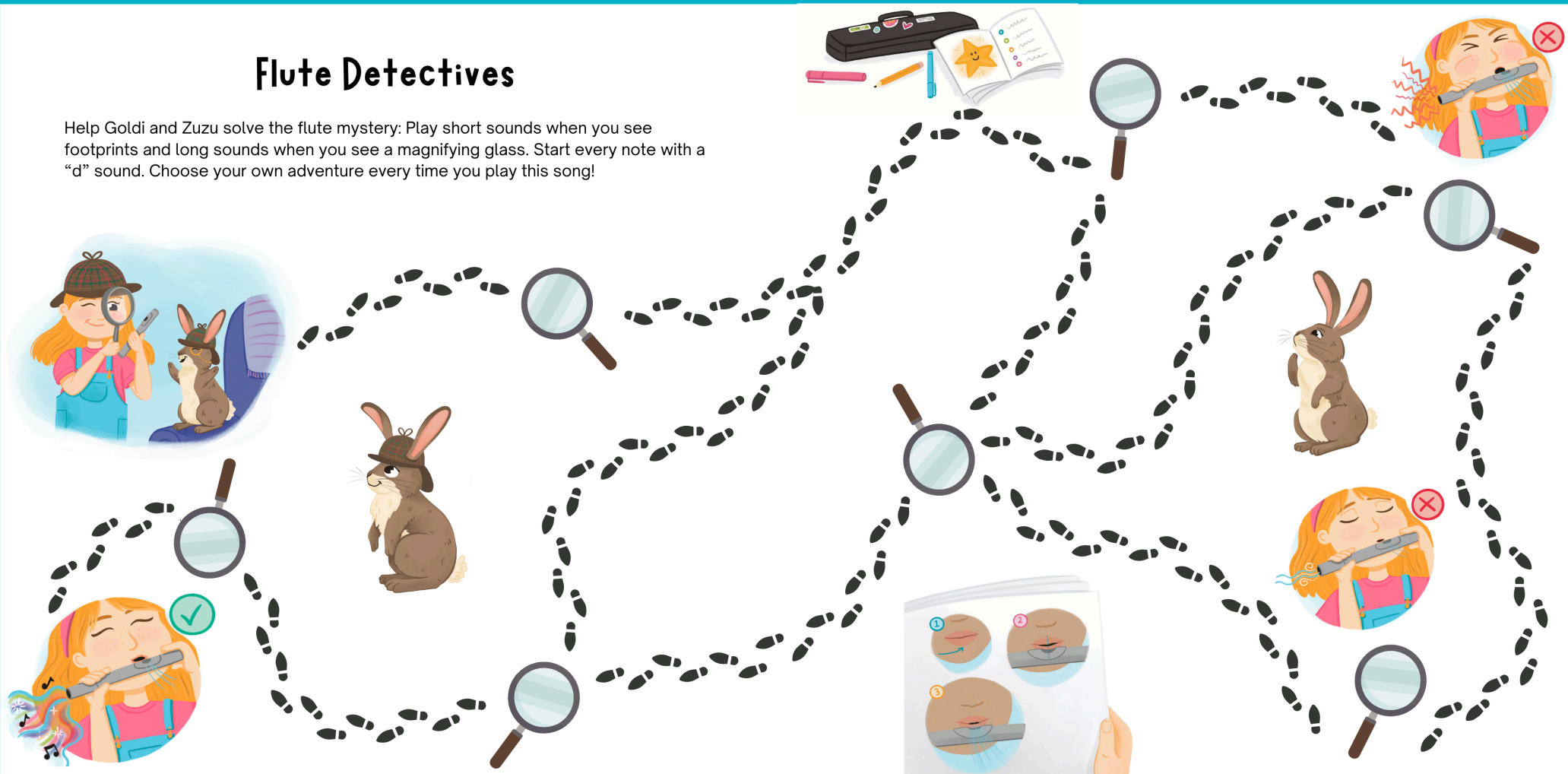
You can play *Flute Fantasy* with Goldi on your flute!

If you're anything like Goldi, you've set up an inviting space to practice your flute—but you don't have Goldi's songbook! Scan the QR code to buy your very own copy of Goldi's songbook **and learn all the sparkly flute sounds you can make on your headjoint!**

Until then, here are three songs to get you started: *Flute Detectives* plays with short and long sounds, *Prickly Pots* plays with high and low sounds, and *Playful Pencils* plays with wavy sounds.

Flute Detectives

Help Goldi and Zuzu solve the flute mystery: Play short sounds when you see footprints and long sounds when you see a magnifying glass. Start every note with a "d" sound. Choose your own adventure every time you play this song!



Prickly Pots

These prickly pots are perfect for exploring high and low sounds! When you see a tall cactus, play a high sound. When you see a short cactus, play a low sound. Try something new every time you play this song: for example, pots with two prickly plants can be played as two short notes! Remember to start every note with a “p”.



Playful Pencils

How many wavy shapes can you spot on this page? From orderly pencils to eccentric squiggles, there are many wavy shapes to play! And if you run out of ways to play what's here, you can always add your own wavy lines to the page.



Composed with illustrations (graphic notation) rather than music notes (standard notation), **Goldi's First Flute Songbook** is perfect for beginners with no musical experience: Little flutists will learn and play their long and short, high and low, wavy *and* whirly-twirly roller coaster sounds.
